POLICE ADD FURTHER VOYEURISM CHARGES IN U OF G CASE

On October 25, 2012, a 37 year old Kitchener man who was a former employee at the University of Guelph was arrested and charged for Voyeurism in relation to numerous pictures that he had taken while on campus. The man would get close enough to these females and take pictures up their skirts and shorts, without their knowledge, using his cell phone. The incident was brought forward to the Guelph Police by the University Campus Police, who at this time continue to assist in this investigation.

The Guelph Police have identified further evidence in regards to the behaviors of this male. On January 3, 2013, the Guelph Police arrested and charged him with a further eight counts of Voyeurism. He was released with a court date in February 2013.
